

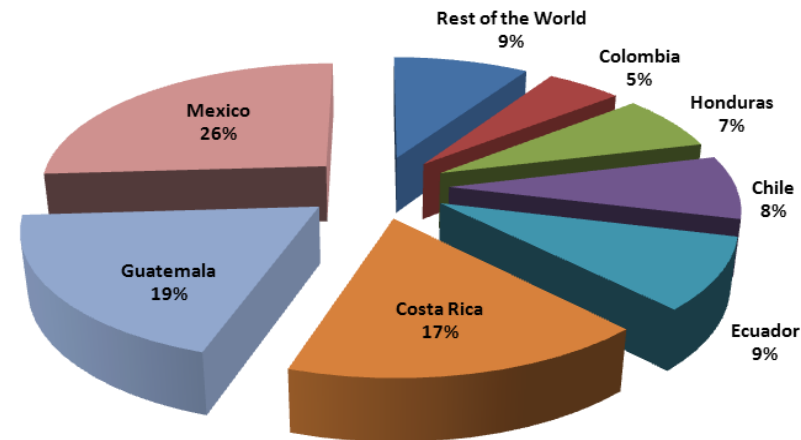

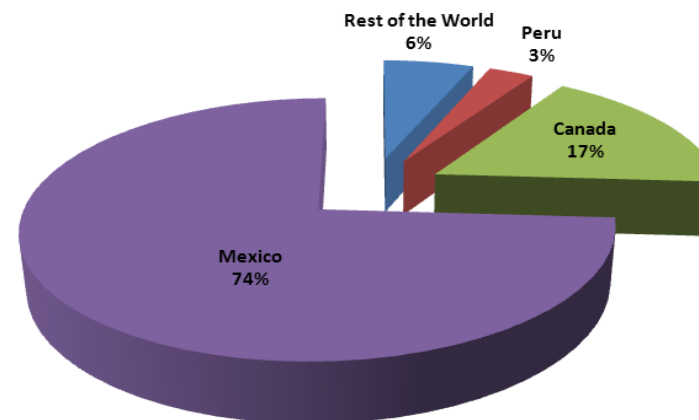

#### COUNTRY OF ORIGIN



Guatemala, Costa Rica and Ecuador supply about three quarters of bananas. Pineapple volumes from Costa Rica have grown 35% since 2008. Mexico is expanding avocados, mangoes and strawberries and is the leading exporter of lemons and watermelons to the U.S.

Vegetable imports have grown by 1.2 million tons over the last five years. Mexico is dominant in tomatoes, peppers, onions and cucumbers and doubled asparagus exports while Canada is tops in potatoes and carrots. Peru has been rapidly increasing onion shipments.

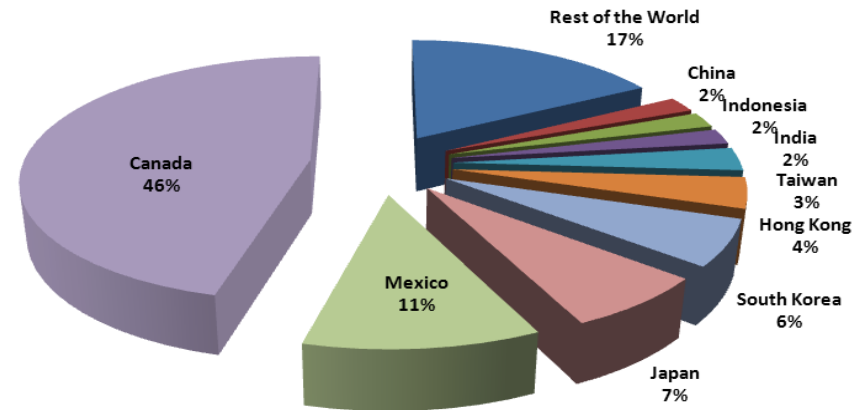

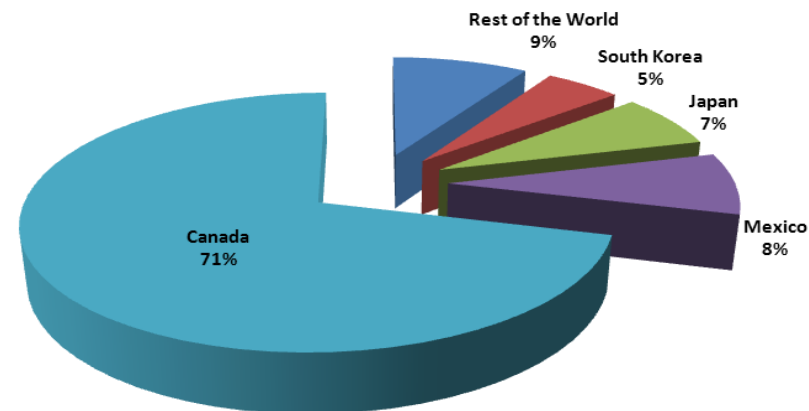

#### DESTINATION COUNTRY



Canada is the leading destination for 7 of the top 9 exported fruits by volume. Mexico receives the most apples and pears while shipments of oranges to South Korea and China have been on the rise. Re-exports to Canada account for 99% of banana activity.

Canada and Japan have been greatly expanding shipments of cauliflower from the U.S. Cabbages headed to Canada grew by 15% in 2012 and celery, potato and onion exports to Asia are also increasing. Potato exports fell slightly in 2012 after four years of double-digit gains.
