Background

Progressive state legislator who has focused on policies related to labor, climate, and reproductive rights in her advocacy work, legislative career, and Congressional campaign

Political career began right after college, when Salinas joined then-Sen. Harry Reid's (D-NV) office in 1996; worked for several members of Congress and a federal employee union before moving to Oregon

Worked as a legislative consultant, lobbyist, and activist on environmental and women's health, and labor issues prior to being appointed to the state House in 2017

Chosen as assistant majority leader in 2019 and was promoted to majority whip in 2021; led the passage of legislation on climate, labor, and health issues, including the Cover All People act, a bill to make undocumented immigrants eligible for state health care

Launched a Congressional campaign shortly after Oregon's new Congressional map added a seat surrounding her legislative district; campaign focused on similar themes to her legislative work, and garnered support from national progressives like Sen. Elizabeth Warren (D-MA)
