Background

An army veteran and president of a Detroit-based supply chain company, James ran for the US House on a platform of free market economic policies

Originally from Detroit, James was inspired to attend the US Military Academy at West Point by a friend of his father who served in the Vietnam War; following his graduation from West Point, James completed an eight-year military career that included two years of combat duty in Iraq

After retiring from active duty in 2012, James has led James Group International, a Detroit-based supply chain management company that his father founded in 1971; also holds the title of CEO of subsidiary company Renaissance Global Logistics

As one of only two 2020 GOP Senate candidates who ran against Democratic incumbents in states won by Trump in 2016, James was propelled into the national spotlight; he campaigned with Trump in Michigan and attracted significant fundraising from national Republicans in the 2020 election cycle

In January 2022, James launched his third congressional campaign for Michigan's 10th district
